
Christmas Musical Celebration

Current By-Law Language in Section VI. CHURCH MEETINGS; Section 1 Worship Services

The church shall meet regularly each Sunday morning and Wednesday evening for preaching, instruction, evangelism and for the worship of the Almighty God. These meetings will be for the membership of the Church and for all people and shall be conducted under the direction of the Pastor. Any changes will be approved by the Church Council.

By-Law Change Presentation at the end of worship 10/10/21

Bob Morgan: "At the July Quarterly Business Meeting, the subject of when the church is meeting and when the By-Laws state meetings are to occur was discussed. From that discussion, a change request has been presented to Vision. The change request modification is for Section 1 Worship Services under Church Meetings and expands the days that the Church 'shall meet' from just Sundays and Wednesdays to any day of the week. It also opens the door for these meetings to be open for All People, members and guests and said meetings can be conducted by the Pastor and/or designated guests or invited leaders."

Bob Morgan: "The proposed change reads as follows; 'The church shall meet regularly each Sunday morning and during the week for preaching, instruction, evangelism and for the worship of the Almighty God. These meetings will be for all people (members & guests) and shall be conducted under the direction of the Pastor, and/or designated guests/invited leaders."

Bob Morgan: "I would like to make a motion to approve the requested change to the By-Laws."

Perry Holland: "A 'Second' is requested by the meeting moderator. The moderator announces the motion will be discussed at this Tuesday's Quarterly Conference Meeting and voted on by the church on Sunday, the 24th (not the 17th as there will be an outdoor service that day)."

At Quarterly Conference on 10/12/21 this motion was tabled until further notice. The request comes from Deacon's Meeting on 10/11/21 and a request was to have all language in the November Messenger.
