As we turn the calendar to 2023, I want to thank all those who participate in our Music/Worship Ministry and in our Outreach Events Ministry!



It's hard to believe 2023 is upon us! I hope everyone had a great holiday and everyone is making progress on their New Year's Resolutions!

With winter now upon us, youth basketball is in full swing! Each Saturday throughout the winter, we host about 120 boys from churches across the city including Myers Park Presbyterian, Myers Park Baptist, and Covenant Presbyterian to name a few. During the week, we also host additional 60 boys during the week for practices among different age groups and organizations. Pritchard plays an important role in the Impact Youth Basketball League and ensures all game day and practice experiences for the kids are memorable.

The league provides us a chance to teach our young boys how to play basketball and the importance of teamwork, fellowship, and sportsmanship. This year, we have 30 boys in our program ranging from ages 5-9 years old. Many of our kids haven't had the opportunity to play in an official league with referees, jerseys, and scorekeepers. The looks on their faces when they got their jerseys was priceless! Pritchard Recreation was able to provide full scholarships for about 15 kids, including 13 from Charles Parker Elementary. By providing full scholarships, we give kids and their families a chance to play basketball and receive mentorship they would have access to otherwise; it is a crucial part of our mission and ensuring we give back to our community. Going forward, our goal is to continue this partnership and expand it much further. The goal for next season is to scholarship 20-30 kids and have 60-70 enrolled in our program.
