One of the things we're working on as a staff right now is: Sunday checklist. Each of us on the church staff has a slightly different work week and different expectations for every Sunday. So, the question is, how do we make sure we are prepared and ready to facilitate spiritual growth and worship for the family of God each week?

The Sunday checklist is one tool that we use for that. Essentially, we ask ourselves what are all the things that are our responsibility each week. For me, right now, that means making sure our tech team has my scripture, checking to make sure we have coffee and cups in the Gathering Place, preparing for my class if I am facilitating one... oh, and making sure I have something to say in my sermon!

Each of our staff is working on a checklist for each Sunday, but what if our church members had a checklist to make sure that we prepared ourselves for worship? What would a worship checklist look like? The following are just a few thoughts, there are many that others that could be included, and this is in no particular order.

A checklist to prepare for worship:

- Reflection on the week that was. What has God showed me of Himself this week? How has God provided for me? Was there something from the sermon last week or from my Connect Group that stuck with me? Is there a discipline I'd like to practice more?
- Prayer for God's leading. Take time to ask that God would bless you with ears to hear, eyes to see, a heart to worship. How often do we really take ourselves to God in prayer before a worship service, so that we can be prepared to interact with the Almighty?
- Relinquishment of any grudges or bitterness. Grudges are like a poison we swallow hoping to harm our enemies (paraphrased quote). But how often do we hobble ourselves into the presence of the risen Christ harboring resentment? What might it look like to walk in with fresh hearts and free minds? This is easier said than done, but it can be a major part of the preparation in prayer to God's deliverance from resentment.
- Pre-reading the scripture or reflection on the topic of the day. I know, I'm not always 100% on getting the scripture out ahead of time, but if it is, how often do we read ahead and ask God to speak through his Bible BEFORE worship?

I would encourage you to work on your own kind of checklist. Not in a legalistic type way, we don't believe that this makes us saints before God because we know that only the grace of Christ has made us saints. But we do know that the Holy Spirit wants to empower us to grow spiritually. How often do we quench that Spirit by not preparing ahead? I am excited about our upcoming series, and I encourage you that as you begin to prepare for worship intentionally, God will bless you with His presence and closeness. See you soon!


